

2024 Product Update

The following changes apply to <u>new sales</u> made on or after October 5, 2024.

1. We added a new \$5M + premium rate band to Equimax[®]. The new band applies to policies with \$5,000,000 and more of basic Equimax insurance coverage.

This will allow Equitable® to better support large case market needs.

Clients who buy \$5M or more of basic Equimax coverage now get more initial coverage than before with the same premium payment outlay.

- 2. We lowered the cost of EquiLiving® critical illness (CI) policies paid monthly. The monthly CI premium rates and policy fees were reduced.
 - The monthly modal factor for CI has changed from 0.09 to 0.0867.
 - The monthly policy fee for CI has changed from \$4.50 to \$4.34.
 - EquiLiving premium rates and the annual policy fee have not changed.
- 3. We lowered the monthly cost of EquiLiving CI riders that are added to Universal Life (UL) policies.

CI riders added to UL policies are now more affordable per month.

- 4. We changed the commission calculation on Equimax participating whole life insurance, Term life insurance and EquiLiving CI policies when clients choose to pay premiums monthly.
 - a. **Before** the commission was based on the annual premium even when the premium was paid monthly.
 - b. **Now** the commission is based on the <u>total premium</u> paid for the policy year when monthly payments are selected.
- 5. We changed our Equimax reduced paid-up (RPU) insurance rates effective October 5, 2024. The new rates are included in our updated sales illustration software.
- 6. We introduced a new <u>Evidence of Insurability Schedule</u> on October 5, 2024. The age and amount requirements for life insurance and critical illness products have changed. Learn <u>more</u>.
